If you have Medicare Part A and Part B, then the COVID-19 vaccine will be at no cost to you. But it is important to know how the COVID-19 vaccine will work with your Medicare plan.

The COVID-19 vaccine is going to be billed through Medicare Part B. This means, whether you are on a Medicare Advantage Plan or a Medicare Supplement plan, you will need to bring your red, white, and blue Medicare card when you go to receive your vaccine. It is important to remember to bring this card as the provider is going to need your Medicare Beneficiary Identification (MBI) number listed on the card.

If you have delayed Part B due to being on employer coverage, then you will need to contact the employer plan to see how the COVID-19 vaccine will be covered.
